Case SCARBAN combined with ALHYDRAN: Dog bite

1. Case study description

patient age	10 years
gender	boy
cause	dog bite
why scar treatment	 no expectation of scar improvement increase in hypertrophy poor mobility of the finger (dig 3 left) persistent itching and redness
start scar treatment	3 months after bite
therapy	6 months of intensive scar treatment: - SCARBAN® Finger (including pressure stocking) at night - ALHYDRAN cream (2 to 3 times daily) during the day

3. Conclusions medical team

At the start of treatment, the scar looked bad: reactive and no signs of improvement. Within 3 months of scar treatment improvements are already visible.

SCARBAN® Finger at night: - scar became more relaxed and smoother

- improved mobility of the hand - less itching, pain and redness

4. Patient experience

In order not to restrict the 10-year-old boy at school and while playing, a combined treatment (ALHYDRAN medical cream + SCARBAN® silicone scar treatment) was prescribed.
